Artificial pitch review as requested by Cllr Mike Burtenshaw

1	PROJECT PROPOSAL
1.1	To consider a review of football pitch provision in West Swindon particularly access to artificial floodlit pitches.
2	INTRODUCTION
2.1	Cllr Mike Burtenshaw has observed that there are limited options for all weather pitches in West Swindon. This has potential to be an income generation opportunity.
3	LOCAL OPTIONS
3.1	Grass Pitches There are a number of options for renting grass football pitches in West Swindon. The following schools have a grass pitch available: Brookfield School Hazelwood Academy Millbrook School Peatmoor Primary School Shaw Ridge Primary School Westlea Primary School Tregoze Primary School.
3.2	All Weather Pitches For all weather pitches, the options are fewer: Link Centre – 3 artificial pitches Peatmoor Primary School – 1 artificial The Deanery (out of Parish) – 1 artificial. Costs are generally £30 for an hour on an all weather pitch and all are floodlit.
3.3	Five A Side - Kickabout The Parish Council has a number of spaces for five-a-side and kickabout: Sparcells Saltway/Middleleaze Westlea Shellfinch Bloomsbury Bess Road (single goal end)
4	IMPACT
4.1	Access to affordable all weather football pitches may open up opportunities for more local children and adults to access league football across the Parish. Many artificial pitches are created in a way that

	enables multiple sports to be played.
6.	BUDGET
6.1	Possible implications. The Parish Council has no allocated budget for the development of sports pitches. Installation costs range from £300,000 to £500,000. Annual revenue is estimated to be between £50,000 to £100,000. It is possible that grant funding could be applied for e.g. Football Foundation/National Lottery. However timescales may be lengthy.
7	FINANCIAL & OTHER IMPLICATIONS
7.1	Consideration would need to be given as to whether or not this is the type of long term investment that would benefit residents in West Swindon.
8.	RECOMMENDATIONS
8.1	That this Committee notes the information in this report and details any further steps to be taken.
