1. Background

1. Residents in West Swindon have been actively litter picking and looking after green spaces for many years. The Parish Council's Clean and Green fund acknowledges this voluntary contribution by allocating an amount per reported volunteer hour or session. The funds can be allocated by those who have contributed hours, on Clean and Green activities in their neighbourhood. An individual person contributes £5 per hour and a group contributes £30 per session to the neighbourhood pot. Where a project is an established community space, the funds may be ringfenced to fund improvements to that space. Areas cannot accrue or spend more than £2,000 across a rolling two year period.
