# 1. <u>Services Work Completed (4 weekly update)</u>

- 1.1 Noting the Christmas closure, the Parish Council team focused on litter and flytipping in the week before Christmas. Routine work over the last four weeks as follows:
  - Fly tipping and bin emptying increase in waste collection due to ongoing collection of plastic waste presented in bags and use of litter bins for dumping of household waste
  - Hedge and shrub cutting Toothill and Freshbrook
  - Routine play inspections

The team collected 10 tons of waste from litter bins, 13 tons of green waste, half a ton of hardcore and 2 tons of wood across the weighbridge in December.

### 1.2 Play improvement work has been undertaken including

- Fencing at Nine Elms replaced
- Scraping path edging at Shelfinch
- Site meetings at Bess Road for replacement MUGA

### 1.3 **Project Work**

The team have completed

- clearing green waste from volunteer work (Risingham Mead)
- clearing dirt and debris from walkways after subways have drained
- monthly pick up after volunteer group litter picks
- manual removal of falling/fallen trees ongoing (Grange Park, Peatmoor, Blagrove, main roads)
- Christmas event Westlea Fire Station
- moss scraping Toothill
- big litter sweep along Tewkesbury Way to Hook Street
- mower repair and servicing ready for the new season
- hand tool repairs
- full shrub and tree maintenance and tidying around Toothill Village Centre
- maintenance at Blagrove allotments (division and tidying)
- bin replacement Mannington subway

### 1.4 **Income Generation:**

### 1.5 **Requests for Service:**

The team have received a range of requests from the public, mostly faulty street lighting, broken glass, SBC waste collection queries, leaf clearance and flytipping. Councillor requests: volunteer waste collection, moss clearance, fallen trees, bin emptying, information requests, parking queries, blue bag collection, and flytipping
