Subject: Services Update

1. Services Work Completed (4 weekly update)

- 1.1 During the last four weeks, the team completed the following:
 - Started mowing rounds Councillors should note that the mowing fleet cuts at a 2.5 inches or higher, this allows for buttercups and daisies to remain. Bluebells and daffodils will be avoided until they have died back.
 - Scraped moss from splitter islands
 - Low level tree and fallen branch removal
 - Strimming
 - Cleared subways and steel barriers around roadside verges
 - Graffiti removal
- 1.2 Play improvement work has been undertaken including
 - Jet washing play surfaces
 - Swing pivot repaired and spinner repaired
 - Removal of broken music panel at the Chesters unfortunately not repairable and will need replacing
 - Rubber surface repairs at Clayhill play area

- Cleaning and painting the horse sculpture at Claypits/Cartwright Drive
- · Replacing the wood on benches at Cartwright Drive
- Weeding and refilling the brick planters at Freshbrook village centre 8 tons of top soil
