Subject: Services Update

1. Services Work Completed (4 weekly update)

- 1.1 During the last four weeks, the team completed the following:
 - The team completed play inspection training
 - Continued mowing rounds
 - Scraped detritus from car park surfaces at Toothill and Freshbrook village centres including weed removal
 - Tidied ground level planter beds
 - Rotavated and tidied planters at Shaw and Freshbrook
 - Cleaned and cleared bridges around Peatmoor lake
 - Cleared vegetation from Mead Way (Bible Society to Bridgemead roundabout)
- 1.2 Play improvement work has been undertaken including
 - Made safe retaining wall barrier at Claypits play area
 - Rubber repairs in play surfaces
 - Repainted shelter at Bloomsbury Park
 - Welded new bars in the fence at Shelfinch

1.3 **Project Work**

The team have completed

- Collected woodchip from Stanton and delivered to volunteer copse groups and allotment
- Created sculpture balls for Freshbrook Village Centre planters
- Sprayed out some invasive plants in public open space
- Created and posted signs for volunteer areas
