- 1.1 Residents in West Swindon have been actively litter picking and looking after green spaces for many years.
- 1.2 Since April 2018 we have introduced a grant fund pot to reward these activities. An individual person contributes £5 per hour to the pot and a group contributes £30 per session. Where there are a small number unless the combined value of individual hours would be less
