

WEST SWINDON PARISH COUNCIL**Clean and Green Volunteer Report****1. Background**

- 1.1 Residents in West Swindon have been actively litter picking and looking after green spaces for many years. Since April 2018 we have introduced a grant fund pot to reward these activities. An individual person contributes £5 per hour and a group contributes £30 per session.
- 1.2 Each group has cap at £2,000. This means that a group can accrue a maximum of £2000 in any two consecutive calendar years.
