Name of project or activity?	Reinstate Crossing Patrol at Hazelwood Academy
<u>Who</u> is it for? and <u>where</u> is it happening?	The crossing patrol would be reinstated on Stokesay Drive, Toothill. This will directly benefit the pupils, parents and staff of Hazelwood Academy in Toothill, by ensuring Hazelwood Academy pupils are safe when travelling to and from school. Most of our schools pupils live in the local area and walk to school and those who drive from other parts of Swindon park in the car park across the road and have to cross the road to get to school.
How will residents in West Swindon benefit from this?	A crossing warden on Stokesay Drive at the start and end of the school day will minimise the very real and ongoing traffic risk to children and other members of the community who need to travel this route on their way to school.
	Since the retirement of our previous crossing patrol officer there have been numerous accounts of dangerous driving and near misses reported. We are extremely concerned at the ongoing high level of risk and potential for harm to both are children and other members of the

	community which has not yet been addressed by SBC.
When you aim to start and finish?	We anticipate this funding will help us provide a crossing patrol person for a minimum period of two years during which time we can investigate more permanent solutions to the road safety issue for the school and wider community and hopefully liaise with SBC on their ongoing road safety strategy.
What funding are you	List of items and amounts:
requesting from the Parish Council?	As crossing patrol officers must be appointed by or on behalf of the council we are asking SBC to recruit and training a crossing patrol warden on our behalf.
	Further to review of the Crossing Patrol Officer role profile which has been provided to us we estimate the cost of a crossing patrol officer for 1.5 hours a day 5 days a week during term time 38 weeks a year for two years to be £6,000 including on-costs.
	An additional amount will be needed for recruitment and training
	We have raised £5000 through a successful grant application to Toothill Big Local and therefore are asking the Parish Council for a sum of £1.5k to enable this project to go ahead (25% of the anticipated costs).
