Introduction:Caroline Hunt – Great Western Community Forest

Caroline introduced the work of the Great Western Community Forest which links a number of tree planting initiatives together including Trees for Climate Change and the Queens Green Canopy. The overall goal is to achieve 350 hectares of tree planting over the next five years. Last year was a challenge. Moving forward there are four identified sites at the current time in West Swindon:

- Wiltshire Wildlife Trust at Rivermead
- Peatmoor Copse Group
- Shaw Forest Country Park
- Shaw Ridge Linear Park

Trees will be sourced through a joint buying framework. Native species will be selected. The project will provide trees and will pay for labour if planted in-house. No finite timescales however the progress is generally reliant on nursery provision and availability. Schools have been invited to participate. Wide scale community planting is welcome.

The team is working closely with West Swindon Parish Council to identify sites, support planting and community involvement and link with wider aspirations on community orchards and restoring backland areas.
